



Retired since 2013, Brother Joe Icet, former Pipefitter turned Farmer is making his mark on this Earth right here in our own Community. He has been an instrumental figure in turning our Inner City Fifth Ward District into an amazing farming project. He calls it FarMart, also known as The Emile Street Community Educational Farm . The farm is located in FifthWard in the industrial ruins of the Comet Rice Mill. At one time it was the largest employer for residents in FifthWard. Today, a farm that has a 4500 gallon water catchment system that is used to keep the pond full, a Vermaculture project, hens for egg production, Beekeeping, and an event area for stage and food presentation. The farm just recently hosted 218 first graders from HISD's Mark Twain elementary school. The farm has received donations from CoreNet and Lowe's that have helped structure one of the most beautiful Urban Farms in the Country. The farm also receives support from the Mayor's Office, Prairie View A&M, Houston Police Union, Dr. Lester King from Rice University, PipeFitters Local Union 211, and Dawn Burton from the Cooperative Extension. The farm also received praise and recognition from Professor's at Texas A&M University. The farm is open 6 days a week from 9am until 6pm Monday thru Saturday. Sunday the farm Supports the Eastend Farmer's market open from 10am until 2pm on Navigation across from the Original Ninfa's.
